

Our artisan-rendered hand finishing paired with our state-of-the-art finishing technology, creates a flawless finish that you have to see and feel to believe.

Every kitchen is built one cabinet at a time and finished flat to achieve the maximum coverage and create a durable, long lasting finish. A great finish is only achieved with great sanding. All of our cabinets are hand sanded to create the perfect surface application for our finishes. Hands on sanding techniques, combined with the finest high tech equipment available, results in a finish you just need to feel to believe.





1 — Sanding

Fill all undesired voids with recommended wood filler or putty. Eliminate raw wood imperfections by hand sanding.

2 — 1st Coat Primer

Primer is agitated until pigment is completely dispersed. Catalyst is added and agitated. One coat of primer is applied and allowed to dry, followed by scuff sanding.

* All sealed areas are scuff sanded and then the dust is blown off with compressed air.

3 — Second Coat Primer

Primer is agitated until pigment is completely dispersed. Catalyst is added and agitated. One coat of primer is applied and allowed to dry, followed by scuff sanding.

* Any undesired voids or imperfections that still exist are filled. They are allowed to dry and then all sealed areas are scuff sanded. The dust is then blown off with compressed air.


4 — Enamel Topcoat

Topcoat is agitated until pigment is completely dispersed. Catalyst is added and agitated. One coat of material is applied and allowed to dry for 6-8 hours before being handled.













We insist on a meticulous fit because that is what we're known for.

We hand fit our doors to their corresponding openings in order to make sure that each cabinet always has that perfect fit. Both flush and beaded inset doors and drawers are painstakingly sanded by hand and individually numbered to ensure that each door and drawer fit precisely in the opening for which they were made. Take a look at our inset doors and drawers to see exactly what we are talking about!













With cabinet floors flush to the front frame, cleaning is quick and sliding dishes in and out is a breeze.

We build our cabinets with floors flush to the front frame, making it easier to clean and to slide dishes in and out. All of our cabinets are manufactured with full tops, creating a cabinet that is perfectly square and keeps out dirt & dust during installation. The best benefit of the full cabinet top? A drawer which is virtually jam-proof!













Pennsylvania craftsmen bring your designs to life the old-fashioned way — one cabinet at a time.

We use time honored construction methods to build our cabinets. Real woodworking techniques like mortise & tenon, piece by piece frame construction, fully captured bottoms & backs and dovetailed drawer boxes are used. You will enjoy knowing that true Pennsylvania Dutch craftsmen make your designs come to life, one cabinet at a time.



Frameless

- Dovetailed drawers are %" thick solid maple on all four sides. The drawer bottom is fully captured and made of ¼" plywood. Our drawer guides are undermounted and concealed, with full extension and a whisper guiet soft close feature.
- All cabinets (excluding vanities and sink bases) are constructed with a full ¾" sub top. This keeps debris out of the drawer boxes and guides, while also keeping the cabinets perfectly square and creating a virtually jam-proof drawer.
- 3 All shelves are ¾ " thick and fully adjustable on a 32 mm drill pattern. Wall and taller cabinets have full depth shelves, while base cabinet shelves are 16" deep.
- 4 Bottoms and sides of the cabinet are ¾" thick, utilizing wood dowel construction. Backs are ¼" thick, fully captured. A 5" high by ¾" thick hang rail is incorporated for installation.







Frame

- Dovetailed drawers are %" thick solid maple on all four sides. The drawer bottom is fully captured and made of ¼" plywood. Our drawer guides are undermounted and concealed, with full extension and a whisper guiet soft close feature.
- 2 Front Frames are ¾" thick solid wood with mortise and tenon joints with dado construction. Standard framing is 1½" wide
- 3 All shelves are 34" thick and fully adjustable on a 32 mm drill pattern. Wall and taller cabinets have full depth shelves, while base cabinet shelves are 16" deep.
- 4 Bottoms and sides of the cabinet are ½" thick. On the exterior, a ¼" thick matching wood species is added for a finished side. Backs are ¼" thick, fully captured. A 3" high by ¾" thick hang rail is incorporated for installation.









Plain & Fancy uses only the best veneers. All of our hardwoods are sourced from trees harvested in a sustainable manner, mainly from the east coast. In fact, both our cherry and walnut are from our home state of PA. By working with many of our suppliers for 30+years, Plain & Fancy receives the finest hard wood and veneer products available. Trending European styles are also supported, with laminated products, foils, acrylics and glass.

Cherry

Grade AA hand selected veneers

Specifications include:

- Consistent pink to wheat color across panel (not red)
- 2. New York & PA stock with minimal sap wood on face and minimal cluster of tight pin knots
- 3. Restrictions on figure/shadow and no shake or tear, tight glue lines, no discoloring





Maple

Grade AA hand selected veneers

Specifications include:

- 1. Consistent creamy white color
- 2. New England stock preferred
- 3. NO HEART WOOD, or mineral stain on faces
- 4. Minimal worm track, no stain or defects.









Phoenix Collection

Our new collection of contemporary door styles is a great way to achieve a true modern look for your design. The collection includes a combination of reconstituted veneers, textured veneers, and textured melamines.

Milano

- » Milano is an Italian made, textured melamine on a particle board core. It is available with both 18 mm and 22 mm thickness options. It includes 12 very popular finishes and textured edge banding.
 - * Please note: Milano textured melamines are only available with the Milano door style and are limited to our frameless line of cabinetry.



Radison

- The Radison collection is comprised of various reconstituted wood veneers. It is an engineered wood that we offer due to its outstanding physical and chemical characteristics. Created from natural logs, engineered wood is superior to natural wood in texture, color, density and intensity.
 - * Please note: Radison reconstituted veneers are only available with the Radison door style and are limited to our frameless line of cabinetry.




Ridge

- Ridge is a heavily textured wood veneer product. A thick face veneer is abrasively brushed and combed, which pulls the softer wood fibers and leaves the hard textured grain producing a tactile look that is both clean and rustic. Pleasant effects are produced when stained, glazed, or even painted.
 - * Please note: Ridge is only available in Hard Maple, Maple, Walnut, and Rift Cut White Oak wood species. Ridge is also only available in the Ridge door style and is limited to our frameless line of cabinetry.









With Plain & Fancy you can dress up the sides of the cabinetry in many different ways. Unlike many other manufacturers our standard finish side is a **no upcharge option**. You could also make the cabinet sides match the door style on the front of the cabinet, or even directly match the side to the inset look of the rest of the kitchen. Whatever door style you prefer we are here to help.








Adding designer ends on your cabinetry with nonworking doors or beautiful beaded panels ensures it is stunning from every side.
