**A Traditional Statement**


**Surrounded**

### *Farm-esque*

*This kitchen's modern conveniences are nestled in a farm house feel with creamy colors, artisan-looking cabinets with slightly worn finishes, wide moldings, open shelving, and a work island placed right up to a round table begging for company, coffee and pie.*

## Wide Open Spaces

A trend these days is open, open, open. Here cabinetry wraps around the island, leading to the dining area that skips outdoors when the weather is right. A wood inset in the tile floor and a tray ceiling define "indoors" when the wall is open.





### Entertaining Kitchen

*The stacked silhouette of these wall cabinets is chic, heightened by the use of contrasting Beach White and Stone paint together. Glass doors add even more dimension while flip-up doors smarten the overall effect. The stainless farm sink flanked by decorative posts and hefty farm-style island anchor this perky room.*



### *Opposites Attract*

*This large great room/kitchen combo is friendly and bright, even though its colors are as opposite as day and night. This kitchen isn't defined by walls, but by darker, stylishly understated cabinets. The transition from living area to kitchen is achieved through upholstered bar chairs on the "lighter" side of the island and a crisp, white countertop.*





***Fun and Functional***  
Combining your storage and function needs not only saves space, but notches up the fun factor. This dining area features benches with built-in storage beneath. And the bench's high back creates a multi-level surface above the sink in the adjacent kitchen. And never underestimate the value of an oversized island.



### *Reading Nook*

*Many kitchens have an eat-in area. This one has two: the island and the library. By adding bookcases to the built in bench seating, it can double as cozy family study area while the cook is working nearby.*




*Quiet Fancy.*


